A message from your president

n April 1, the flood gates opened at our store and we have been running hard ever since. Spring has been unbelievable weatherwise and many of us have capitalized on the early summer-like temperatures to turn everything from excavation equipment to lawn and garden tools far earlier and more often than anticipated.

The new construction season also has generated much firmer demand for equipment than a year ago. For me, that pressure has meant blown

budgets and the need to hire new employees. In fact, in order to meet rental demand at our store, I spent more on new equipment in April than I had planned to spend over the entire year! I've made purchases to develop new equipment lines as well as expand existing fleet numbers. The demand has come fast and it has come furious. For instance, on two key purchases

this spring, I required the units in my yard ready for rental within 48 hours of placing the order. One piece was delivered to my shop April 6 at 1 p.m. and was on site working at 4 p.m. It is now early May and that was the last time I physically saw the unit. The other unit was delivered on time and has seen high rates of utilization; the salesman returned later to check on things and was stunned to see the number of hours we have put on it.

These are all very, very good (and welcome) signs of recovery.

I would like to thank our members who have welcomed CRA Ontario into their operations this season: Vulcan Demolition, Rentquip Canada,

Affair Rentals and Stihl Canada. Being in the rental industry is more than a full-time commitment. Your willingness to give your time to CRA Ontario to improve the association's programming and in opening your location as

host to our members is invaluable to the industry

What you need to do to be in compliance with Bill 168

B ill 168, an act to amend the Occupational Health and Safety Act with respect to violence and harassment in the workplace and other matters, goes into effect June 15, 2010. At this time, workplaces in Ontario will be required to have the necessary policies, programs, procedures and measurements in place.

Will you be ready?

When Ministry of Labour (MOL) inspectors come in to check your workplace for compliance, they may:

- Ask your employees what instruction/training they have had.
- Check that policies are posted.
- Review health and safety records, minutes, incident reports, etc.

According to the new bill, you **must**:

Assess the risk of violence.

- Prepare workplace policies for both violence and harassment.
- Develop and implement a program to protect workers from the risks identified.
- Inform and instruct employees on the program and procedures.
- Create a process for responding to complaints and threats.


